PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

July 11, 1946.

Re: Hajime INOUE, Reg. No. 09740

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 11, 1942 in which he reported that he owned no property of any kind in the protected area. He was arrested on May 22, 1942 and released on March 2, 1943.

At the time of his arrest 12 \$5.00 War Savings Certificates were seized from this man and turned over to this office for safe-keeping. These were surrendered in December, 1942 at this man's request and the account of this man was credited with the sum of \$48.59 as the surrender value.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$7.35 received as refund of 1% wage deduction for 1941.

On January 6, 1943 we remitted \$25.00 to INOUE and on August 21, 1943 we remitted \$27.28 to the Department of National Revenue to pay overdue income tax for 1941 which INOUE referred to this office.

We are today remitting the balance in the amount of \$3.56 to INOUE.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

1. The writer, accompanied by Sgt. H.P. Price, patrolled the Japanese community in Vancouver on May 12th at which time found the above named, who was supposed to leave the Protected Area by order of the B.C. Security Commission on April 13th, 1942. Subject gave no reason for having failed to leave, but stated that he refused to leave under any circumstances.

SUB-DIVISION

2. He was consequently apprehended, placed in custody at the Immigration Detention Building this City under Military guard and receipt for his living body is held on file.

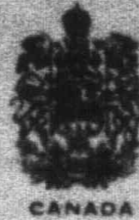

Your letter of the 5th instant is to hand, in connection with your assessment notice for 1941. According to the return you filed, you actually contributed to the support of your parents, \$500.00, which amount is all that can be allowed to you. Further, two other relatives contributed to the support of your parents, and brother; D.u. Inouye and K.B. Inouye. The assessment notice would therefore appear to be correct, and in place of \$42.00 being allowed to you for National Defence tax, \$14.00 was the maximum that would be applicable.
