Dear Sir: Re Policy # 363422 - George Obokata

In reply to your letter of November 8th, we are enclosing a photographic copy of the application for insurance made to this Company by Mr. Obokata on the 29th of July, 1943 through our branch office in London, Ontario. You will note that this man applied for the policy himself, and that he paid the sum of \$12.88 to our representative on the 4th of August, 1943. The balance of the premium was paid on August 28th.

The policy is a \$1,000.00 contract on the 20-year Endowment plan and the beneficiary is Miyo Obokata, mother of the insured. Premiums are payable every three months dating from the 5th of August, 1943 in the amount of \$13.11. The date of birth is stated to be the 19th of November, 1915, and the present address is 259½ Wellington St., London, Ontario.

We hope these particulars will be of assistance to you and you will note that the policy was not in existence as at April 14th, 1942. *(Date of evacuation)*


In answer to your letter of May 12th, 1948 in regard to a War Saving Certificate issued to me in 1941, I would like to have you cash it and send me the money.


Dear Sir:
