

GENERAL SUMMARY

This 21-year old Canadian-born Millworker from Port Alice, B. C., signed a Custodian "No Property" card on the 7th April, 1942.

He was interned on May 16/42 (P/W A-364) and released Aug. 25/43.

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.

Real Property: None.

Personal Property: No chattels disclosed in file.

Bills Receivable: Refund of 1% wage deductions (Jan./June, 1941) was credited to this account in the sum of \$8.48.

Refund of transportation expenses from Port Alice to Vancouver was credited to this account on July 20/43, in the sum of \$12.45.

Bonds, Shares, etc.: War Savings Certificates (\$60.00) and War Savings Stamps (\$6.25) were turned over to this office May 30/42, by the Commandant of Petawawa Internment Camp. Redemption value (\$48.66) of War Savings Certificates received Feb. 2/43.

Bank Accounts: None.


Life Insurance: A Sun Life policy for \$1500.00 was turned in to this office Aug. 20/42 by the Commandant of Angler Internment Camp for safe keeping.

Liabilities: There are no liabilities recorded in this file.

Funds: There is a balance of \$7.14 standing at the credit of this account at the present time, representing transfer from No. 2 (Internee) account. This is being remitted to evacuee today to permit of closing of this account.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.


