

MORI registered with the Custodian on April 14/42 and was evacuated on Oct. 3/42. He signed a yellow "No property" card stating that he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in the protected area of B.C. However we were advised that he was the registered owner of the fishing vessel the "Gray Eagle" which was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$148.50 and this sum was paid to MORI on March 19/42.

There are no claims on file against MORI.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
