

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File 3791.

Kazuo INAMOTO

Reg. No. 09247.

This 28-year old Canadian-born Millhand, from Hillcrest, B. C., signed a Custodian "No Property" card on the 7th April, 1942. He was interned on May 16th, 1942, and released from internment June 8th, 1943.

His wife, Tomie, File 8543, signed a Custodian "No Property" card on the 8th May, 1942. She was evacuated on the 10th September, 1942.

Real Property: None.

Liabilities: None.

Personal Property: None declared, but Mr. R. J. Funnell, 837 West 7th Ave., Vancouver, was given permission by this office (Oct. 8/46) to ship a tool chest, a trunk, and 4/5 boxes of effects to owner.

Specified Articles: A Kodak camera turned in to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, was released (Oct. 23/43) to the B. C. Security Commission for delivery to owner.

A Pontiac car turned in to the Police by this Japanese, and eventually sold for \$396.00, turned out to belong to his father, Otomatsu INAMOTO, File 9152, in which file it is carried.

Bills Receivable: Refund of 1% wage deductions made during the period, January/June, 1941, was collected by this office and credited to this account, in the sum of \$6.57.

Pension (@ \$20.00 per month) received monthly (December '42 - June '43) from Workmen's Compensation Board, and credited to this account.

In his letter of Jan. 14/46, Kazuo INAMOTO reported that Tomisaburo KOZAI (File 3895) owed him the sum of \$300.00, which was later (Jan. 22/46) confirmed by Debtor, who requested payment from his account. However, the Dept. of Labour, Japanese Division, in their letter of Feb. 25/46, would not approve of this debt being paid, as it was not registered at the time of evacuation. No further action has been taken by this office with regard to this debt.

Bonds, Shares, etc.: Eleven War Savings Certificates (@ \$5.00) turned into this office (July 9/42) for safe-keeping, by his wife, were returned to owner on June 21/43.
