PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

In his declaration to the Custodian, April 10, 1942, this man who was interned on May 16, 1942, stated that he owned no property of any kind, in the protected area.

Life Insurance: On May 28, 1942, he reported from Petawawa Internment Camp that he carried life insurance in the amount of \$1,000.00. This policy, as reported by the insurance company, was Sun Life Assurance Policy 2,239,317, 20 year endowment. No premiums were paid through this office and this policy did not come under the control of the Custodian.

Moneys Owed to This Man: In July, 1945, the sum of \$1.70, received from the B. C. Electric Railway Co. Ltd., being security deposit for light, was credited to the account of this man.


