We are in receipt of your letter of April 23rd  
for which we thank you.

We approve your recommendation that the owner

may be stored after evacuation, if he so wishes, but in  
this connection, we mention that the Custodian is anxious  
that as far as possible all Japanese should be encouraged to  
make their own arrangements for disposal of personal prop-  
erty prior to evacuation. In such cases their proposals  
should be submitted to you and passed on to us with your  
comments and recommendations, for approval.

We shall be glad if you will see Mr. Nagami again  
and ascertain from him whether he is interested in making  
arrangements to dispose of his equipment along the lines  
suggested.
