Replying to yours of the 8th instant regarding the above named. We are enclosing herewith, as requested by you, a cheque No. 9981 for 48.00 for the above named man.

With regard to his enquiry about the \$50.00 still due him from Yoshio ICHINA, this money has not yet been paid to the Custodian. We suggest that KOYANAGI should write to his direct, his address is:-

We would appreciate if you would ask KOYANAGI to reply to our letter of the 20th of May, 1944 in which we asked him to authorize us to pay the B. C. Electric Railway Co. \$1.81. With regard to this claim we quote from the B.C. Electric Railway Co. letter, explaining how it was arrived at:-

"He signed for the service originally in November, 1934 and the final was taken in April, 1942. The final bill amounted to \$4.81 from which we deducted the Security Deposit of \$3.00, leaving the balance owing of \$1.81."

KOYANAGI'S radio was sold and netted \$25.60. If he will forward to this office the Receipt given to him by the R.C.S.P. those funds will become available to him.

We regret that no reply had been sent to yours of the 19th of January, 1945. The letter unfortunately has only come before the writer with yours of the 8th of March, 1945.
