PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

This file reveals the above owned no real property in any protected area of B.C., and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: The above, who registered with the Custodian on April 15/42, signed a yellow "No property" card stating that he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of B.C. However on Feb. 8/43 we received a net form listing two nets that the above stated he had left at the Pacific West Cannery. Two nets were found in the name of the above at this Cannery and inventoried under Custodian numbers 1793 and 1794 and sold for the total sum of \$80.00 and this sum credited to the account of the above with this office.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: According to information supplied to this office the above was the registered owner of a fishing vessel the "J.N." which was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$418.25. Out of this sum the purchaser was paid the sum of \$232.85 which the above still owed the B.C. Packers Ltd. on the vessel, and the balance in the sum of \$185.40 was paid to NOMURA on April 7/42. Full details are given on Specified Articles Summary on file.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
