The fishing vessel "Carloda N" Reg. #158,917, was registered in the name of Misaho NODA.

This vessel was sold by the registered owner to J. H. Todd & Sons under bill of sale dated February 7th, 1942, for the sum of \$5,000.00.

Payment was made to the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee on March 2, 1942 (Ledger Folio 41).

After the deduction of the Committee's charges of \$50.00, from the sum of \$3,210.00 paid in to the Committee, the balance of \$3,160.00 was paid to M. Noda on March 5, 1942.

There is nothing to indicate that any one other than Misaho NODA had any interest in this vessel.


Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:
