This woman, who was evacuated on September 8, 1942, signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 17, 1942.

In her declaration she reported 20 items of personal and house-hold effects left in Cumberland. Of these a bed and two mattresses were discarded as valueless; a stove was sold by the owner and payment made to her husband direct by the purchaser; two beds and some blinds were sold by the Custodian for the net sum of \$3.56, which has been credited to the account of Mrs. NISHIMURA; and the balance of her chattels were taken away at the time of evacuation or were shipped to the family later in 1942.

Mrs. NISHIMURA declared, left in Safety Deposit Box, at Royal Bank of Canada, Cumberland, \$200.00 in Victory Bonds and \$55.00 in War Savings Certificates. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

Canada, Cumberland, \$1,900.00. This did not come under the control of this office.

Mrs. NISHIMURA declared two life policies on her husband's life: Policy No. 887,683 - \$1,000.00 and Policy No. 887,701 - \$1,000.00, both apparently with the Sun Life Assurance Co. of Canada. These did not come under the control of this office.
