Chattels: This woman declared a quantity of chattels, all of which have been shipped to her. Two old beds found in her former residence were abandoned as valueless. An old range with sawdust burner and an old gramophone, which were found in her former residence, were sold at auction on February 21, 1945, for the net sum of \$2.34, which was credited to her account.

Securities: Victory Bonds to the value of \$100.00 and War Savings Certificates to the value of \$130.00, in the owner's possession, were declared. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

In your declaration to the Custodian on April 17, 1942, you stated that you owned a quantity of chattels left at Cumberland, B. C. According to our records, all these chattels have been shipped to you.

In addition to the chattels declared by you, there were found in your former residence at Cumberland, B. C. an old range with sawdust burner and an old gramophone. These articles were sold at auction for the net sum of \$2.34. This sum is being remitted to you by the enclosed cheque.

You declared Victory Bonds to the value of \$100.00 and War Savings Certificates to the value of \$130.00, which were in your own possession at the time of your declaration. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.
