A shoe repair machine without a motor and some tools for repairing shoes are in the care of Mr. R.H. ash, Royston. Two trunks, two boxes and a sewing machine were shipped to this woman or to her husband, Guntaro KATO; File 11825. An old range, 4 old beds, 2 tables and 3 benches found in her former residence were of no value and have been abandoned.
