With reference to that portion of your letter of the 12th instant relating to the above, we would advise that this Japanese only filled in a "No Property" form dated April 15th, 1942, and for ready reference a copy of this form is attached.

You will observe that the above's address is given as 786 West 9th Avenue, but we think this is an error and should be 786 West 5th Avenue as his son, Kiyoshi Tanisawa, Registration No. 15279, has a half interest in this property with Ryozo Tanisawa, Registration No. 10282, and about which property we are writing you separately—see attached letter of even date.

Respecting Ryotaro Tanisawa, beyond a claim of \$6.00 by Dr. H. Uchida which has now been withdrawn, we have nothing on this man's file.


Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:
