

Dear Sir,

I received your letter of June 7th, 1943, and would like to thank you for your very prompt reply.

By your letter, I am informed that a claim has been made against my eldest son Takashi by Dr. M. Uchida. It has been unknown to us until to-day. If proof of this debt is found we would like you to forward this said amount of 20.00 to Dr. M. Uchida sending us a receipt.

As for the claim lodged by the Provincial Mental Hospital against my son, we are positive that he had nothing to do with that hospital. I am sure it must be a mistake, so will you please check up and verify it? Thank you.

His present address is now in Japan. He left in January of the year 1941, he was to return home in the fall but as war broke out, it was impossible for him to return.

He had been living at home prior to his departure to Japan, so we cannot check through him, also we have no knowledge of his ever having been associated with the said hospital. I am sure that if you check thoroughly, you will find it has been claimed by false accounts!

It is very necessary for me to have this money as my daughter is leaving for Toronto on Monday June 14th and must have this money in case of emergencies and expenses. You can check through the B.C. Security Commission on this account. Please answer immediately as her future depends on this! Her reg. no. is 07399.
