PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Hidehiko FUJIMOTO - Reg. No. 14139

CHATELS: The above Japanese registered with this office on the 10th April, 1942, and at that time he declared leaving a few chattels at the house, where he had been living on Harris Road, Pitt Meadows.

This property was inventoried by our fieldmen on the 18th May, 1942, and were valued by them at about \$10.00. A copy of the inventory was sent to FUJIMOTO on the 5th October, which he acknowledged as correct on the 7th November.

In April 1944, the property was again inspected with a view to removing saleable goods to auction, and a heater and gramophone, were the only goods taken to auction and were sold for the net sum of \$4.22. The rest of the chattels which included 2 tables, 2 chairs and 3 beds, and miscellaneous books, were abandoned on the property as not being worth the expense of handling.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: This file reveals no specified articles.

ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE: Hidehiko FUJIMOTO's son, Kunihide, died at Dryden, Ontario, on the 15th January, 1945, and proceeds of his life insurance policy in the amount of \$857.97, was received at this office in favour of Hidehiko, as beneficiary. Hidehiko FUJIMOTO's liabilities were paid at his request from this amount, and the balance remitted to him.

The B.C. Electric sent in to this office, the sum of \$1.76, being a refund of FUJIMOTO's light security deposit with them.

LIFE INSURANCE: When registering FUJIMOTO declared he had a \$1000.00 Canadian Mutual Benefit Association policy, but this was not brought under control or administered in any way by the Custodian.

BANK ACCOUNT: Although FUJIMOTO did not declare so when registering, the Bank of Montreal, notified us of a small dormant account at Haney. FUJIMOTO was advised, but the account was not brought under control by the Custodian.

BONDS & INVESTMENTS: FUJIMOTO declared he had no investments when registering with the Custodian, but according to the Pacific Co-operative Union he was the holder of one 1937, one 1938, one 1939, one 1940 and two 1941 shares. However as FUJIMOTO owed the Co-operative the sum of \$38.50, his 1937, 1938, and 1939 shares and part of his 1940 share, were written off in settlement of this debt. The balance of his 1940 share and redemption of his two 1941 shares have been credited to his account here, together with interest on his shareholding. FUJIMOTO is also the holder of 100 non-redeemable shares.

This file reveals no other personal property assets.
