



Tomiko FUJIHARA registered with the Custodian on April 15th, 1942 and was evacuated on May 30th, 1942. She declared that the family effects were declared by her husband, Tadaichi FUJIHARA, File 6889 and they have been administered under his name.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES:

This file reveals no specified articles.

ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE:

Mrs. FUJIHARA declared that the following moneys were owing to her husband by a Mrs. Kemp: \$225.00 (about). On August 3rd, 1944 Mr. & Mrs. FUJIHARA were asked by this office to give us further information in regard to this debt, also Mr. Kemp's initials and address. No reply was received and the Custodian took no further action.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES:

Tomiko FUJIHARA declared that she had 20, \$5.00 War Savings Stamps (certificates) at home. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

LIFE INSURANCE:


A \$1000.00 Policy #58190 of the Monarch Life Insurance Co. was held by Mrs. FUJIHARA, the beneficiary of which was her husband, Tadaichi FUJIHARA. She declared that this policy was in her possession.

In January 1946 she applied for the cash surrender value of this policy and a cheque in the amount of \$409.66 payable to Tomiko and Tadaichi FUJIHARA was sent to this office by the Monarch Life Insurance Co. and forwarded on to Mrs. FUJIHARA on January 30th, 1946.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.


Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:
