

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

RE: Shozo MIYANISHI, Reg. No. 10711

This file reveals that MIYANISHI owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS:

Made his declaration to the Custodian Apr. 15/42. - evacuated Sept. 26/42. Shozo MIYANISHI declared a sewing machine, range, bedroom suite, dining room suite and kitchenware, at 1776 Powell St. When the Custodian agent called at this address he was advised that MIYANISHI had either disposed of his chattels prior to his evacuation or had taken them with him. We wrote and advised him of this fact and asked him to confirm this, but he never replied to our letter.

However a bed and dresser were moved from the Continental Daily News Bldg in his name and sold at auction for the net sum of \$26.00. It is quite likely that he disposed of all his other chattels and moved these to this address, 213-215 E. Cordova, prior to his evacuation. This \$26.00 is his only credit with the Custodian.

LIFE
INSURANCE:

He declared an insurance policy with the Sun Life Assurance Co. in the sum of \$1000.00, the beneficiary being his wife, Toshi. He declared another policy with the same company in the sum of \$335.00. This policy was apparently on the life of his father Nisaburo MIYANISHI, a resident of Japan. The cash surrender value of this policy was received by the Custodian and credited to the account of Int. 1415.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.



I have made this quite clear to Mr. Young, who agrees, and mentioned that he had written to Mr. IHASAKI disclaiming responsibility for any chattels that may or may not have been left stored in this building.
