This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 15, 1942. He was evacuated on April 20, 1942.

In his declaration he reported 2 rifles and 2 shotguns surrendered to the Surrey Police. These firearms are held by the R.C.M.P. and do not come under our control.

He reported a car radio surrendered to R.C.M.P., Vancouver. This was released to the B. C. Security Commission on August 9, 1943 for returning to this man.

He reported a \$1,000.00 policy with the Sun Life Assurance Co. This did not come under the control of this office.
