

CHATELS:

The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 15/42 and was evacuated on June 9/42, declared 36 lbs. net twine stored with H. TSUCHIYA, 800 Block Union St., Vancouver, and 150 fathoms each cork and lead lines stored at the Star Cannery, Steveston, B.C. No trace of these goods has been found by the Custodian. We wrote to the above on January 21/43 regarding his net twine but received no answer from him. The cork and lead lines were not found by us at the Star Cannery.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES:

According to information supplied to this office the above was the registered owner of a fishing vessel, the "T.K.", which was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee to the Canadian Fishing Co. Ltd. for the sum of \$1200.00. A mortgage of \$500.00 held by the purchaser was discharged, and the balance of the sales price, \$700.00, was paid to the J.F.V.D.C. Supervision costs in the sum of \$17.00 were deducted and the balance of \$683.00 was disbursed as follows:
