Dear Sir, Re P/W P-1377, IKARI Minoru.

We are in receipt of your letter of the 9th inst, file # 588, Legal Section, regarding gear said to have been left here by the above man.

We have made a search through the items left here and have located four skates of Dog Fish Line and one Coil of Buoy Line, bearing this man's name. This is not to say that the balance of the items claimed is not here, but we would like to point out that all of this gear from the Japanese was put ashore here in a hurry, during the off season, when only the Winter Watchman was here.

We understand that the gear was placed on the Cannery Floor under the supervision of the Naval Patrol Boat in charge of the operation, and that the Japanese were instructed to tag each piece for future identification.

It is found, however, that several pieces are here with no identification marks on them, and we are not prepared to state to which of the men these pieces might belong.

It would appear to us that the suggestion which has been made that all relinquished gear be shipped to a central sorting and distributing point in Vancouver is a good one.
