This file reveals the above owned no real property in any protected area of British Columbia, and that he did not carry any Fire Insurance.

Chattels:

The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 15/42 and was evacuated on May 19/42, declared a few chattels left in a house on Moncton St., Steveston. None of these goods were found by the Custodian as noted in memo of Aug. 5/44 from Custodian agent, Mr. G.M.Harris.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES:

According to information supplied to this office the above was the registered owner of a fishing vessel, the Silver Queen, which was sold through the office of the Custodian for the net sum of \$388.89, and this sum was credited to the account of the above with this office. Full particulars are given on Specified Articles Summary on file. It is noted that the above was advised of the sale of his vessel in our letter of July 13/43. After some further correspondence, he finally wrote us on June 19/44 objecting to the sale of this vessel.

On July 3/44 the above asked us to pay from his account to the B. C. Security Commission the sum of \$128.89, being a refund of maintenance advanced to him by the B.C.S.C. from the time of his arrival in Greenwood. We accordingly sent the B.C.S.C. on July 10/44 a cheque for this sum made out to the Receiver General of Canada, and debited the account of the above with this amount, leaving his balance at \$260.00.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

You wrote me regarding the reason for sale of my boat, recently, the letter I misplaced, so have forgotten the date. However you mentioned that I did not make use of the Japanese Vessel Owners Committee to dispose my boat the "Seloe Queen", this fact I am sorry to state must be quite an error on your part, because I did make use, as records must show that I placed my boat for sale to the committee, however, there were no buyers, and I couldn't be allowed to stay in Vancouver to make a sale, so left the matter in their hands. I would like to have this sale recorded as against my wish, because when you did get a buyer you didn't even notify me, and I believe as a British subject the boat registered in my name makes me the sole owner.

Dear Sir:

Your file has been reviewed and it is noted that when you made your declaration to the Custodian on April 15th, 1942, you declared some effects left at the house where you were living at Steveston, known as "Tanaka's Bunk House" on Moncton Street. Included in the goods declared were two shrimp nets which you stated were in the S. TANAKA bunk house, not in the care of anyone, and that there was no key to this house. You also declared ownership of a fishing vessel, the "Silver Gull", in custody of Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee at New Westminster.

Our Steveston agents reported to this office that when they went to the S. Tanaka bunk house on Moncton Street to inventory the goods found there, that they discovered this house had been looted and ransacked before they had taken over this area, and that there was nothing of any value left there.

Your fishing vessel was sold through the office of the Custodian for the net sum of \$388.89, and this sum credited to your account with this office.

On July 3rd, 1944, you asked us to pay from your account to the B. C. Security Commission the sum of \$128.89, being a refund of maintenance advanced by them from the time of your arrival in Greenwood. We accordingly sent the B. C. Security Commission a Custodian cheque for this sum and deducted it from your account, leaving your balance standing at \$260.00. You were notified of the amount of your balance by our Mr. Wood on his recent visit to Greenwood.


