

Referring to your letter of February 24th, addressed to Mr. Hiroyoshi Jack KOBAYASHI, JR. #11534, this City, upon receipt we forwarded same with the enclosure of cheque in the amount of \$0.88 requesting him to return the Form G-111 with his signature. His reply was as follows:

> "Enclosed is the cheque and form G-111-A which I am returning. I do not wish to accept it as I want to claim it back for which I have a receipt."

He called into the office and his story was that it was understood when he released his radio that it would be held for him until cessation of hostilities and then returned, and he has a receipt, so he states, covering this arrangement. No doubt, he will take this matter up direct with your office.
