GENERAL SUMMARY

July 11, 1946.

Re: Hirovoshi KOBAYASHI, #11534

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 15, 1942 in which he reported drums and radio equipment left at 1935 First Ave., Vancouver. These could not be located and KOBAYASHI confirmed that these had been disposed of prior to his evacuation.

The N.C.W.P. handed to this office a radio transmitter which was sold through this office and the net proceeds of 88 cents credited to his account. This amount was remitted to KOBAYASHI on February 21, 1945 but he returned the cheque, refusing to accept it as he claimed he has a written agreement that this radio equipment would not be sold.

Referring to your letter of February 24th, addressed to Mr. Hiroyoshi Jack KOBAYASHI, JR. #11534, this City, upon receipt we forwarded same with the enclosure of cheque in the amount of \$0.88 requesting him to return the Form G-111 with his signature. His reply was as follows:

"Enclosed is the cheque and form G-111-A which I am returning. I do not wish to accept it as I want to claim it back for which I have a receipt."

He called into the office and his story was that it was understood when he released his radio that it would be held for him until cessation of hostilities and then returned, and he has a receipt, so he states, covering this arrangement. No doubt, he will take this matter up direct with your office.
