The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 15/42 and was evacuated on April 26/42, declared no chattels. Nevertheless a trunk bearing his name was found at House #6, Imperial Cannery, and was inventoried on June 15/42 by Custodian agent, C.C. Robinson, in the name of "K. MORISHITA", on List #1, File 4175. K. MORISHITA, File 4175, is the father of the above. This trunk and one clock, which was part of the contents of the trunk, were sold at Steveston auction #39 for the net sum of \$4.76, and this sum credited to the account of the above.

A purse and a counting board have been parcelled up and we are holding these articles until we hear from the above as to his wishes in the matter. These were also part of the contents of the trunk.

The file reveals the above owned no specified articles.

This vessel was released from custody to the licensed owner, B. C. Packers Ltd. February 27, 1942.

The vessel was reported to the J.F.V.D.C. as being owned and licensed by Masaru MORISHITA. However, the licence was in B. C. Packers' name and the naval control number in the name of K. MORISHITA probably Kichisaburo MORISHITA, father of Masaru.

We have no record of what interest, if any, Masaru Morishita had in this vessel. He did not declare ownership when he registered with the Custodian.
