They are Hiroshi Yoneda, Porenosuke Katsukawa, Achiyo Mase, Hisao Hamada, and Pamiyiro. - Yamashita, Mr H. Hamada has just a camp stove and a kitchen stove in with us. Mr P. Yamashita has just a bed room sets in with us, so our ch missing chattels should be in with H. Yoneda, T. Katsukawa, A. Mase and those chattels which does not belong to us should belong to those former three persons.

I wonder if you have received my brother's letter, (Yaku Yamamoto) asking if you can send over our bicycle (there should be a pair of tires and a pair of tubes) and two fencing uniforms sets, if you would just be kind enough to let us know if you can send them

over to us or not

P.S. Those people who have their chattels with us didn't live with us, they just stored their chattels with us in the same house.
