CHATEL SUMMARY


Re: Mrs. Ryutaro (Nobuko) NAKAGAMA

Evacuated May 24th, 1942.

Mrs. Nakagama declared on April 15, 1942, certain chattels left at 81 Moncton Street (see schedule). This was never checked by the Custodian's agent.

According to a memo on file dated March 25, 1944, a fire was incurred on January 14th, 1943, completely destroying this house. As no insurance was carried on the chattels, no further action can be taken.

It is noted further in a letter from NAKAGAMA that certain goods were left at 80 Moncton Street, being the home of Mrs. Sogawa, file #9863 (see schedule). Mrs. Sogawa admits that these goods were in her house. From goods removed, we can only identify and transfer to Mr. Nakagama's account the couch, dresser & mirror, and the small table which we take to be a bench. The balance cannot be found. The reason these were transferred to Mr. Nakagama's file, is that Mrs. Sogawa said they belonged to him.
