The above named Japanese certified in her declaration of April 15, 1942, that she had certain furniture and personal chattels in her possession at 1889 Triumph Street, Vancouver. Under the "Remarks" column she states that the furniture will be left at the above address and the personal effects taken when she is evacuated. On investigation, we were informed that she had sold most of her furniture and taken the balance to Alberta. This was confirmed in a letter dated October 23, 1942, from Mrs. MIYAUCHI.

There are no specified articles of any kind revealed on the file.

No property interests other than those mentioned are found on the file.
