This file reveals the above owned no real property in any protected area of B.C., and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS:

The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 14/42 declared fishing nets to the value of \$330.00 to be left at the net house of the Brunswick Cannery, Ladner, and personal belongings in his own possession, which he stated he would take with him at the time of his evacuation.

Two nets tagged with the name of the above were found at the Brunswick Cannery and were sold direct to that cannery for the total sum of \$170.00 and this sum credited to the account of the above with this office.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES:

According to information supplied to this office the above was the registered owner of a fishing vessel, the "Y.T" which was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$990.00, and this sum was paid to Yukihiro TAKASAKI on March 16/42. Full details are given on Specified Articles Summary on file.

ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE:

On May 22/43 the account of the above was credited with the sum of \$27.10, being a refund of National Defense tax for 1942.

LIFE INSURANCE:

The above declared one insurance policy with the Monarch Life Insurance Co. in the sum of \$1500.00, the beneficiary being his brother Yukio, and a policy with the Manufacturers Life in the sum of \$1000.00, the beneficiary in this policy also being his brother Yukio. These policies did not come under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

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this too.

One other thing I would like to inquire about, is a bed I left at Brunswick Cannery, Ladner, along with the other things. I didn't have it registered, but I had my name on it. I am sure you must have come across it.

I am very much in doubt about these things that I have stated above, so will you please write to me in detail, explaining everything to me.

The National Defense Tax, referred to in your

you assume in your letter. This made your total credit amount to
\$197.10 and was sent to you in our cheque on October 9, 1946.

We note you are inquiring about a bed and other
things which you did not register with the Custodian. We regret to
say that no other articles were found in your name by the Custodian.
