In his declaration of April 15, 1942, NISHIMURA declared a fishing net, value \$25.00, at the Carlisle Cannery, Skeena River, B. C. This was sold for the amount of \$25.00 and credited to NISHIMURA's account on September 16, 1942.

There are no cameras, radios, motor vehicles or fire arms revealed in the registration or the file.

Life Insurance:

NISHIMURA declared a Sun Life policy in the amount of \$1,000.00 in owner's possession.

This man was originally interned under file no. 867 (Internee).


NISHIMURA requested a loan on the above policy, no. 2,238,255. A cheque was received by the Custodian on June 16, 1943, from the Sun Life, in the amount of \$152.15 and credited to his account. The policy was requested by the Custodian, received from NISHIMURA's mother, and placed in safe-keeping. NISHIMURA later applied for the cash surrender value of the policy and a cheque was received from the Sun Life in the amount of \$6.10 on December 14, 1943. This in turn was sent to NISHIMURA on December 21, 1943. The policy was sent to the Sun Life on December 14, 1943.

Cash on Hand:

As this man was an Internee, his bank balance which was held in the Royal Bank of Canada at Steveston, was requested, and a cheque received from this bank on Sept. 11, 1942, in the amount of \$2.28. This amount was credited to his account and is being forwarded to NISHIMURA today.

No personal property interests other than those mentioned are revealed on the file.
