

GENERAL SUMMARY

Yukitoshi IZAWA died at New Denver, B. C. on June 21, 1946. He is survived by his widow, Shisue, file No. 7806, and one daughter, Mary Etsuko IZAWA, a minor.

The deceased declared no assets and no liabilities to the Custodian.

We were advised on December 31, 1942, by the Sun Life Assurance Company, that they were paying Yukitoshi IZAWA a monthly Total Disability Benefit of \$10.00 under the provisions of his policy No. 672,991. These payments were continued until the demise of the policy holder.

Claims were filed against the deceased as follows:

Provincial Board of Health (T.B. Unit).....	\$4905.00
a/c Harry Yukitoshi IZAWA -	\$420.00
a/c Mrs. IZAWA -	2832.00
a/c Mary Etsuko IZAWA -	1653.00

Toshaiki SUMI.....\$ 100.12

These claims were admitted by Mrs. IZAWA on behalf of her husband but she stated that they were unable to pay as they had no funds and Mr. IZAWA was seriously ill in the New Denver Sanatorium. The creditors were advised accordingly.

The Department of Labour filed a claim against the Estate of the deceased for the sum of \$80.00 to cover funeral expenses. They have been advised by this office that no funds are available to pay the claim.

We learned, from a telephone conversation with Mr. Hay of the Sun Life Assurance Company, that they were holding, on deposit at 3% interest, the sum of \$621.14 for the beneficiary, Mary Etsuko IZAWA, who is a minor. This amount being the policy value less a loan of \$350.00 plus interest.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file.

In reply to your letter of August 17th, in which you make claim for recovery of the sum of \$80.00 to cover funeral expenses of the above deceased Japanese, we regret to have to advise that there are no funds to the credit of the Estate in this office. We wrote to the widow asking what arrangements she wished to make with regard to this claim but she replied that she has no resources whatsoever from which to meet her obligation.

The Sun Life Assurance Company policy on the life of Yukitoshi IZAWA was payable to the daughter of the insured as beneficiary but, as she is a minor, the money is being held on deposit by the Company until she reaches her majority.

In reply to your letter with reference to the account amounting to \$80.00, funeral expenses of the above gentleman, his wife has asked me to write you to the following effect.

The insurance policy will bring in only about \$650.00, and it is payable to Mary, a minor. That sum will be all she has to begin life on her own when she becomes of age. In the meantime it is in trust for her.

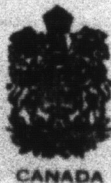
