PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. 4346

August 30, 1946.

RE: Kazuo Ryukichi NAKANO, Reg. No. 01080

This file reveals that the above owned no real property in any protected area of British Columbia, and carried no Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: The above, who registered with the Custodian on April 21/42 and was evacuated on June 13/42, signed a yellow "No property" card stating that he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of British Columbia. Nevertheless the file reveals that on Oct. 29/42 we received from the Phoenix Cannery the sum of \$187.78 for nets and gear sold in the name of the above. Memo of Jan. 20/43, from Custodian agent at Steveston, identifies Kazuo NAKANO as being the owner of this fishing equipment. The proceeds had been previously credited to Kiichi NAKANO, File 2499, who fished for the B.C. Packers Ltd. and had also declared no property.

Nets and gear found in the Phoenix Cannery net house were inventoried by Custodian agent, C.C. Robinson, on June 19/42, as per net statement on file dated Jan. 25/44, and sold for the total sum of \$417.78 (this includes amount mentioned above of \$187.78), and this sum was credited to the account of Kazuo NAKANO. (NAKANO had been sent a net form on June 8/43 to fill out, and he sent this completed form back to us on June 24/43.

The row boat appearing on the net form was not found or identified by us as belonging to Kazuo NAKANO, although several row boats have been sold and the proceeds credited to Net Suspense Account as the owners could not be identified. We have therefore transferred the proceeds from sale of one of these boats, namely one sold on Nov. 19/42, Custodian No. 600, sold from the A.B.C. Packing Co. for the sum of \$10.00, to the account of Kazuo NAKANO.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: According to information supplied to this office the above was the registered owner of a fishing vessel, the "K.N." which was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$492.50 and this sum was paid to NAKANO on May 14th, 1942. Full details are given on the Specified Articles Summary on file.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
