Dr. Schinbein was advised of father's and daughter's addresses.

Dear Sir: Re: File No. 4356.

I received your letter of June 12th while we were very busy doing beet work so I was not able to answer it until now.

I regret that I have not been able to repay any of the debt to Dr. Schinbein during the past two years because we have been able to earn barely enough for our living expenses and our crops have not been very good. However, I hope to be able to send you at least a part of what I owe when we are paid for our year's work in November or December.

We have worked very hard but the wages here are very low and the cost of living in Raymond is relatively high. Since all my six children are girls raised in the city, we cannot do much work such as haying or threshing and my eldest daughter had the misfortune to injure her foot on the first day of the best working season this year, so we are having a rather difficult time.

I am very sorry indeed to keep Dr. Schunbein waiting so long for he has been very kind to us. Please explain to him that we shall pay him as much as possible ^{towards} ~~at~~ the end of the year.
