I have today checked up with the Sun Life in connection with the above numbered policy and find that the present cash value would amount to only \$90.00 after deducting automatic premium loans and that it would only purchase a paid-up policy to the extent of approximately \$140.00.

On the other hand, contrary to the first information we had, to the effect that the policy would expire December, 1945, we find that it will carry itself to at least December 1946. The matter has been considered in this office and it has been decided to make no change and to allow the policy to carry itself as at present under the automatic non-forfeiture loan.
