Dear Mr. Wright: Re: Isumi TANIYAMA

The above repatriated to Japan on August 2nd, 1946,
he being 20 years of age at that time.

He did not turn in any cash, and the Treasury Department issued a draft in his favour for \$200.00. Any cash he may have had would doubtless have been turned over to his father who went back to Japan at the same time. The Treasury Department advised us in the usual way that Isumi TANIYAMA was indebted to them for the sum of \$200.00 and that if we should receive funds at any time, they should be paid to the Treasury.

A letter just received from Taniyama indicates that he is now back in Canada residing at 548 College Avenue, Winnipeg. It would appear that in regard to Japanese who are being allowed to return to Canada, no enquiries are made as to whether they have any indebtedness to the Treasury Department. We realize of course that this is not a matter for our jurisdiction, but I thought it should be brought to your attention.
