

Ichinosuke OKAMOTO died in Vancouver, B. C. on July 19, 1943. According to information on file, the deceased was a widower with no children and both of his parents were dead.

The deceased declared no assets to the Custodian and none are revealed on the file. The only claim appearing on this file is for the sum of \$351.00, claimed by the Provincial Board of Health for hospitalisation of the deceased. They were advised by this office on November 13, 1944, that the deceased had no assets as far as we were aware and there was, therefore, no possibility of the claim being paid.
