Additional Information: This boat was licensed in the name of Totakichi MORI. The licence was issued in 1918. The boat was said to have been built in 1934. The survey says the engine was older than the hull, <sup>estimated</sup> to be 20 years old. If the hull was the one for which the license was issued it would have been more than 20 years old. It is possible that the hull had been rebuilt, or again the old licence may have been placed on an entirely new boat. Totakichi MORI, to whom was issued licence NW.199 is not registered with the RCMP.
