GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Juhachi MATSUO - Reg. No. 12959

The only asset declared by the above Japanese was a Western Mutual Travellers Aid Society policy for \$300.00. This was not brought under control by the Custodian.

According to the records of the United Farmers Co-operative Union he was the holder of a \$10.00 share in it. This share was sold by the Custodian for \$65.00, and this sum together with \$3.20 interest on same, was released to his credit upon receiving his share certificate on the 11th February, 1946.

Juhachi MATSUO had three claims filed against him.

Mrs. TAHARA's claim was paid direct, according to MATSUO's letter of the 7th March, on the 17th June, 1944.

M. Nishiguchi Company Limited account was settled through this office for \$68.20, in full settlement in accordance with that Company's letter of the 4th April, 1946.

We wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 11th February, with which was enclosed your \$10.00 United Farmers' Co-operative Union share. This share was sold for \$65.00, and this sum together with interest totalling \$3.20 has been credited to your account here.

It is noted on your file that M. Nishiguchi Company Limited has filed a claim against you for \$90.77, and Mrs. Saga TAHARA, one for \$70.00. You confirmed both accounts were owing by you, and it would appear that no payment has been made on the debts.

As your credit balance here is \$68.20, an additional \$92.57 would be necessary to make payment in full of these accounts. Please advise if you are in a position to send this sum to assist in their settlement. If not, please advise us what sum you would be able to send and we will try to arrange on your behalf, settlement in full for you.

We received your letter of the 7th March, from which we note that you had settled Mrs. Suga TAHARA's claim for \$70.00 direct on the 17th June, 1944, and we also note your acknowledgment of M. Nishiguchi Company Limited account of \$90.77.

Please be advised that we have negotiated with this Company on your behalf and they have agreed to accept in full settlement of your debt to them, the sum of \$68.20. This sum represents your credit balance at this office, derived from the sale of your United Farmers' Co-operative share, plus interest on same, and payment of this debt has, therefore, been made.
