There is a foot-note on your account stating that "K. KIMURA" admitted paternity of this baby and promised to pay the Doctor's bill. We are not clear as to who "K. KIMURA" is as we have a father and son, both of whom seem to have a baby of the required age.

The father gave his age as 68 and his occupation as retired, and stated that he had previously been a farm-hand for TASHIRO, Mission.

The son has given his age as 24 and his occupation as fisherman and logger.

We would appreciate if you would let us know by return mail which of these individuals is responsible for the payment of your claim.
