

In March, 1944, we received a notice from the Pacific Co-operative Union that Mrs. TSUJI was a member of the Pacific Mutual Aid Society, and annual dues were owing for 1943 and 1944. These were paid by her husband at his request, in April, 1944, and as he died in October, 1944, notices for 1945 and 1946 dues were sent to her for payment direct.

Mrs. Suze TSUJI is a beneficiary of her husband's Estate, distribution of which has not yet been made, but other than this, her file shows no other assets.
