MEMORANDUM.

Re: Gennosuke KOJIMA, Deceased.

Reference is made to the reported death of the above by the Department of Labour under date, June 8, 1945. This man declared no real property and confirms a statement dated Sept. 29, 1944 on File 2315 that he occupied property, Lots 9 & 10, Sec. 2, Blk. 38., R.W., Map 963 which property is registered in the name of Yoshichiro YOSHIZAKI, resident in Japan. The land has been sold to the Director the Veteran's Land Act.

KOJIMA declared certain chattels of very small total value, the whereabouts of which has not been discovered by the Protection Department. As the Deceased's Estate is nil so far as there is on record, and as he has no credit with the Custodian, it does not seem worth while to pursue this matter further.
