

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

RE: Takeo HAMANISHI, Reg. No. 03601

CHATELS:

The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 20/42 and was evacuated on Oct. 26/42, declared a 3 piece bedroom suite, kitchen utensils, 1 kitchen stove, 3 fishing nets and one row boat. Only the fishing nets and the row boat were to be left at the Starr Cannery, Steveston. The household effects were to be left with the mother-in-law of the above, Mrs. H. HAMAGUCHI, *nee ex W.* at 2nd Avenue, near Moncton St., Steveston. The file reveals that no trace has been found by the Custodian of the chattels declared. The property of Mrs. H. HAMAGUCHI where the chattels were said to be stored, was sold for taxes on Sept. 30/42. The buildings were demolished on orders from the Fire Marshall as having constituted a fire hazard. Owing to the length of time between the date of his declaration and his evacuation, it must be assumed that he either disposed of his goods or took them with him. No nets or row boat were found by the Custodian at the Starr Cannery belonging to the above.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES:

According to information supplied to this office the above was the registered owner of a fishing vessel the "SMOKIE", which was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$538.04, which sum was paid to the Royal Bank of Canada, East End Branch, and credited to the account of Tokotaro TANAKA. Payment to Tokotaro TANAKA had been authorized by Takeo HAMANISHI. For full details see Specified Articles Summary on file. The above was also the licensed owner of a fishing vessel the "T.H." which was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$432.50, and this sum was paid to Takeo HAMANISHI. (Date of this payment is not given on Specified Articles Summary dealing with this vessel).

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.


