The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 20/42, and was evacuated on Oct. 20/42, declared the following chattels left in care of the Manager of the Starr Cannery, Steveston: 2 stoves, (kitchen and heater)

1 bed with spring and mattress
Kitchen utensils and kitchenware

We wrote to him on Feb. 26/46 advising him that nothing had been removed from the Starr Cannery by the 'ustodian, and that no chattels had been found which could be identified as belonging to him. In reply to this letter he advised us on March 7/46 that he had sold the stoves and bed prior to his evacuation and that the kitchenware had been transferred to the home of his friend Mr. F. HAMAGUCHI, but that when he had visited this place before his evacuation the goods were missing. He states further that the kitchenware had practically no value 'and its loss was immaterial to him. He closes by stating that he has no goods in the protected area.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: According to information supplied to this office the above was the registered owner of a fishing vessel the "Y.T.", which was sold through the Japanese fishing vessel Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$492.50, and this sum was paid to Yataro TABATA on April 4/42.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
