PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Tadasu TAKAHASHI - Reg. No. 13813

CHATELS: The above Japanese declared no chattels when registering with this office. He mentioned a buffet in a letter dated 11th March, 1944, but this was handled under his daughter, Rose Kotoyo TAKAHASHI's file No. 4971, as were all chattels pertaining to this family as she was the registered owner of the property on which they lived.

ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE: The Provincial Income Tax department paid in to this office the sum of \$1.59 which was a refund of 1941 Income Tax. The B.C. Electric Railway Company also paid to TAKAHASHI's account at this office, \$3.92, being a refund of electric light security deposit.

BONDS & INVESTMENTS: Although the above Japanese declared no securities, according to the Pacific Co-operative Union records, he was the owner of \$120.00 in non-redeemable shares and \$70.00 in redeemable shares. Of these latter shares, \$40.00 worth have been redeemed and the remaining \$30.00 worth of 1941 shares should be redeemed early next year.

LIFE INSURANCE: Tadasu TAKASHI declared a \$1000.00 Sun Life Insurance Policy. Premium payments on this policy were paid by his daughter, File 4971, with the exception of \$16.93, being part payment of premium loan, which was paid from his own account.

This file reveals no other personal property assets.

Tadamu TAKAHASHI stated that of Dr. Broe's original bill of \$35.00, \$10.00 had been paid in cash, and \$7.50 deducted for fruit and vegetables delivered. Dr. Broe was advised of this and he agreed to accept \$17.50 in full settlement of his claim. This was paid 16th May, 1945. TAKAHASHI denied owing funds to Shotaro NAKAMURA, and Shotaro NAKAMURA was advised that the Custodian would take no further action in the matter.

No other claims appear on file.
