





In a letter, dated December 4, 1942, Yosaburo Hayashi stated that he had sold to Mr. Bob Mansford a fishing net. The sum of \$125.00 was received by the Custodian from Mr. Mansford and credited to the account of Yosaburo Hayashi.

The only nets inventoried by the Custodian's agent, Mr. C. C. Robinson, at the Colonial Cannery Net House were Custodian's Nos. 733 and 734. Net No. 733 was sold for the sum of \$10.00, but there is no record of Net No. 734 being sold by the Custodian.
