The B. C. Security Commission withdrew their claim. The Provincial Board of Health were informed of the low value of the assets of this man under control of this office, and no further action has been taken by the creditor.

In view of the financial circumstances of Teiso YAMAMOTO, the manner in which these liabilities were incurred and the fact that the funds in his account represent the net proceeds from the sale of his former home (salvage value of building on land owned by Canadian Collieries) and chattels, the sum of \$42.40, being all the funds in his account, is being requisitioned as YAMAMOTO has requested.

Received your letter of September 9th and was very disappointed in the way the Custodian is salvaging our houses.

As you stated in your letter of an agreement (re- the right of occupation and use of any structure on the land was to terminate if the occupier ceased to be an employee of the Company); I haven't any slightest memory of making an agreement like that.

Furthermore, it is my sincere opinion that the Canadian Collieries (Dunsmuir) Limited has no right to take over our houses without our consent, even though the land belonged to them. I think it is very unfair, and I can't call this a democratic country if they do things like that.

Just before evacuation, the Company

restricted us from selling or renting our houses. If they did that then, why can they take over our houses now, and salvage it?

The appraisal value of our house is ~~approximately~~ worth far more than \$30.00. Even the house itself cost us \$950 for second-hand, and we put in over \$600 for repairs.

Therefore, I don't want my house salvaged and I don't want it taken over by the Company, either.

I believe I have the sole right to keep our house and its belongings.

I hope you will do the same for me, as it is the Custodian's work to look after our properties and belongings.


