




In her declaration of April 21, 1942, Mrs. Masue Tanino declared chattels left in the Phoenix Cannery House No. 19. However, we are of the opinion, through a letter received from her on January 10, 1944, that she had moved her chattels to House No. 18, which was occupied by Mr. Uhachi Tanino, who we presume is a brother-in-law.

On October 13, 1943, Mrs. Tanino requested the shipment of a sewing machine and a typewriter. We find that the typewriter was in the hands of Mr. Robertson, a book-keeper at the Phoenix Cannery, and the sewing machine was in the hands of another employee, Mr. Ray McKinnon. These items were shipped by the Custodian's agents on November 17, 1943.

The other articles mentioned in Mrs. Tanino's declaration were never found by the Custodian, and in a memo dated February 12, 1945, it is stated that the house had been broken into and only the stove was salvaged. The stove was purchased by the Phoenix Cannery.

We find, on June 5, 1944, that the Phoenix Cannery purchased a number of stoves, in the total amount of \$188.00. These could not be identified so the proceeds have been placed in Chattel Suspense Account.
