GENERAL SUMMARY

This woman, who was evacuated on June 22, 1942, signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 21, 1942.

In her declaration she reported a bank account with the Royal Bank of Canada, Cumberland. This account did not come under the control of the Custodian. Notice, dated January 4, 1946, from the bank gives the Account No. as Savings A 216, and states that there is a balance of \$322.81 in the account. This notice was forwarded to Kiyomi ANPI on January 15, 1946.

The file shows that a sewing machine and a trunk (not declared previously) were shipped to this woman on June 15, 1942.

The file reveals no other property of any kind whatsoever.

No liabilities are revealed on this file.
