PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. 4559

August 24, 1946.

Re: Hisako HAMANAKA #07025

This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 21, 1942. She was evacuated on July 21, 1942.

In her declaration she reported a large quantity of chattels left at Fanny Bay. These have been accounted for by sale or shipment, with the exception of the following: 2 chairs (\$2.00) 3 crocks (\$8.00) 1 sleigh (\$1.75) 1 cupboard (\$12.00) The values given were those placed on these items by Mrs. HAMANAKA. The goods sold netted \$46.55, which has been credited to the account of Mrs. HAMANAKA. See Chattel Schedule for details.

In addition to the chattels she reported, two \$100.00 Victory Bonds; \$10.00 in War Savings Certificates; \$25.00 War Saving Certificate; 3 \$25.00 War Savings Certificates; Savings Acct. No. H-608, Royal Bank, Cumberland, B.C. (\$2,500.00); none of which came under the control of the Custodian, and is believed to be the same (in some cases) as declared by her husband.

She reported Sun Life policy #2250936 on her own life and Monarch Life policy on her son's life. These did not come under the control of this office.

A Chevrolet Coach, registered in the name of this woman, but declared by her husband was sold for the net sum of \$273.02, which was credited to her account.

On May 29, 1943 and June 12, 1943, two cheques of \$100.00 each were sent to this woman, and on July 12, 1943, a cheque for \$73.02 was sent. These remittances represented the net proceeds of the sale of her car.

At the present time her account has a credit balance of \$46.55 (Net proceeds from the sale of chattels), which is being remitted to her today.
