PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Monpei ANPI, Reg. No. 06523

On April 21, 1942, Kiyomi ANPI, daughter of this man signed a declaration to the Custodian as proxy for her father. Mr. ANPI was evacuated on March 15, 1942.

In this declaration a quantity of chattels were declared. Of these the trunk and sewing machine were shipped in June, 1942. The other articles appear to have been accounted for quite well by the auction of November 8, 1944, from which was received net proceeds of \$17.48, which was credited to the account of Monpei ANPI. The articles declared, but not accounted for by sale or shipment are, 2 beds, 1 table, and kitchen utensils. The latter may have been sold as "contents" in the auction. The beds and table, were not, as far as our records show, removed from the house. It is assumed that these, as well as a heater (not declared) reported by Mr. Matt Brown, were found to be unsaleable. A box containing a shrine is stored in the basement of 604 Cordova Street. *SHIPPED
Mar 6/47*

ANPI reported one \$50.00 Victory Bond and 15 \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in his own possession, as well as a bank account, Royal Bank of Canada, Cumberland, B. C. These did not come under the control of this office.

ANPI declared a 6 room house on land owned by Canadian Collieries Dunsmuir Ltd., Cumberland. The sum of \$40.00 was received from the landowner as salvage value of this house. This sum was credited to the account of Monpei ANPI.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$65.38 from the final distribution of assets of the Royston Savings Association. ANPI was reported to be the owner of 25 shares in this association, and on the basis of these shares his account was credited with \$87.53, but as he had endorsed a loan made by the association to K. NAGANO, Reg. No. 07439, File 12217, his account and that of Yasuto ODA, Reg. No. 06474, File 12327, the other endorser, were each debited with the sum of \$22.15 to cover unpaid interest and principal. His net credit from this source was therefore \$65.38.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

On April 21, 1942, Kiyomi ANPI, daughter of this man signed a declaration to the Custodian as proxy for her father. The father had been evacuated on March 15, 1942.

In this declaration the following chattels were declared:

1 Dresser (Sold Nov.8/44 - \$3.00)
2 Tables (1 Table & contents sold Nov.8/44- \$2.10) See below
7 Chairs (7 broken chairs sold Nov.8/44 - \$1.00)
Kitchen Utensils (Box & contents sold Nov.8/44 - 10 cents)
All the above were stored in House #34 Japanese Town #1, Cumberland, B.C.

On January 14, 1943, Mr. Matt Brown reported that the sewing machine and trunk had been shipped; that there were in Cumberland Storage the carton containing the guitar, the chest of drawers, and 3 boxes of bulk effects packed in the home, containing Japanese Country costumes, etc. kitchen-wares, etc. The 2 beds, dresser, 2 tables, 7 chairs and an old cast heater. There is no record of the disposal of the 2 beds, 1 table and the heater.

In regard to the 3 boxes of bulk effects, auction of November 8, 1944, shows the sale of wool for \$2.50, of a box and contents for 10 cents and of a "table and contents" for \$2.10. This last item may mean that some miscellaneous articles were included with the table in the sale, as a table does not seem to be a thing that would have "contents". Some shelves were sold for 50 cents. A carton of old bedding was sold for 25 cents. In Cumberland, as at other points, many beds were found unsaleable. It is assumed that the items that were not sold were found to be unsaleable, as Mr. Brown has been quite satisfactory in his handling of chattels.

A box containing a "Banda cabinet" was shipped from Cumberland on June 4, 1945, and was placed in storage, under Inventory #778, at 604 Cordova. This item, identified by Mr. Wills as a shrine is in the basement at 604 Cordova Street.

Dear Sir:-

The Custodian is pleased to inform you that arrangements have now been completed whereby Canadian Collieries (Dunsmuir) Limited, have taken over numerous houses on their properties that were at one time occupied by persons of the Japanese race.

As the company owned the land, the right to use and occupy such buildings was contingent upon payment of a nominal rent. We are informed that the right of occupation and use of any structure on the land was to terminate if the occupier ceased to be an employee of the Company. The Corporation, however, agreed to pay an estimated salvage value for the buildings, and pursuant to the agreement, the Company's Inspection Engineer, along with our Agent, appraised each building on the basis of its value to the Company, in connection with their building plan.

You occupied the building known as House #35, No. 1 Japanese Town and the award fixed as aforesaid amounted to \$40.00. Your account has, therefore, been credited with this sum.
